

VEOLIA REQUIREMENTS

Recycling Guidelines – Commingle

Place these items loose in the green bin or in blue or clear bags.

- Plastic rigid containers that have a number code on the container.
- Most food, health, and cleaning products are #1 or #2 plastics.
- There are some containers that are #3, 4, 5 or 7. All of these are acceptable as well.
- #6 plastics ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE – most #6 are Styrofoam or clear plastics such as bakery or salad bar containers
- Glass bottles or jars are accepted
- Aluminum cans, foil and trays are accepted
- Steel cans, including aerosol cans
- Juice boxes, milk, and juice cartons are good

Items NOT Accepted

- Aluminum siding, gutters, lawn chairs, doors and window frames or windows
- Appliances, electronics, cellular phones, computer parts
- Batteries of any kind
- Carpets or carpet padding
- Cookware, dishware, clothes hangers (wire or plastic)
- Dishes, drinking glasses, giftware, crockery, windows, mirrors
- Miscellaneous metals: tools, pipes, chains, wire, pots and pans, other scrap metal
- Paint cans that contain liquid or dried paint
- Plastic Bags (grocery, bread, dry cleaning, newspaper), wraps, sheering, curtains, or tarps
- Plastics: toys, buckets, boxes, dishes, vinyl blinds, flower pots, laundry baskets
- Toys of any kind (plastic toys, riding toys, games, game pieces, etc)
- Ring binders, plastic sheet protectors
- Styrofoam: packing blocks, “peanuts”, sheets, plates, cups or containers
- Wood or construction material
- Yard waste or brush

Paper/Cardboard Guidelines

Bundle with twine or put into paper grocery bags. Place in green bin.

ACCEPTED ITEMS:

- Junk mail
- Magazines
- Telephone Books
- Computer Paper
- Writing Paper
- Cereal Boxes
- Frozen Food Boxes
- Books
- Corrugated Boxes
- Newspaper – please remove from plastic bag

NOT ACCEPTED ITEMS:

- Foil-backed Paper
- Paper Towel
- Napkins
- Plates
